Then ERI[®] Fax may be the best scoring and reporting method for you

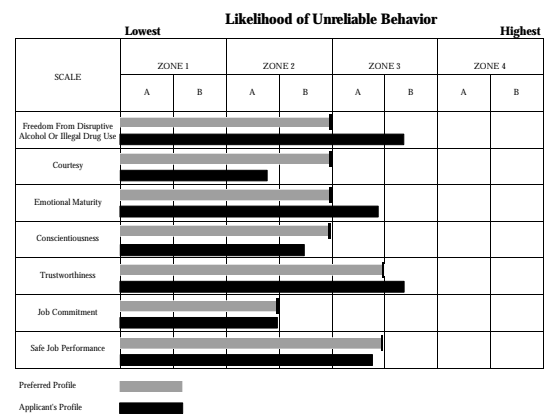
How does ERI[®] Fax work?

- After an applicant completes the ERI[®] questionnaire, it is reviewed for completeness by your staff member
- The questionnaire is then faxed to a toll-free number. No cover sheet is required since each individual ERI[®] questionnaire is individually encoded
- At the processing center, validation software checks each questionnaire for completeness and accuracy, before processing

- Results are faxed back to your preferred location within minutes

Available Report Formats

- **Custom Designed Profiling**
Each applicant's results can be compared to custom designed profiles. You can determine how well an applicant's results compare with your preferred profile.



- **Variety of Report Formats**
ERI[®] results can be reported back to you in a variety of formats. These range from a single page graphical view of the applicant's results to a multi-page comprehensive interpretive report. The comprehensive report includes suggested follow-up questions to be asked in subsequent interviews with the applicant and during the reference checking process.

What do you need to use ERI[®] Fax?

- Users of this method need access to a fax machine in good repair, capable of transmitting and receiving a fax page free of any unwanted lines or distortion.
